

# ANARCHY IN MACEDONIA.

**Albanians Ill-Treat the Christians—  
Notorious Brigand Beheaded.**

LONDON, Oct. 18.—The Balkan States correspondent of The Times reports a condition of chronic anarchy in Macedonia, owing to the lawlessness of the Albanians, whose attitude toward the Christian population is worse than that of the Kurds toward the Armenians.

The Macedonian brigand Maliu, the leader of the assassins of Stambuloff, after some years of prosperity, during which he has been unmolested and even regarded as a hero, has been caught commanding a murderous band and been beheaded by the Turks, who have displayed his head in several Macedonian villages.
